

Kittitas County Park & Recreation District No. 1  
Regular Meeting Minutes  
June 25, 2008

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by vice-chairman Blake. All commissioners were present, with the exception of Kurtz, whose absence was excused.

Carlin moved, seconded by Reason, to approve the draft agenda as distributed. Carried unanimously.

Carlin moved, seconded by Peterson, to approve the draft minutes of the June 9, 2009, meeting as distributed. Carried unanimously.

No citizen comments on non-agenda items, nor public appearances.

Four Seasons Update: Peterson reported that there would be a booth at the Pioneer Days street fair, and an entry in the parade, that the website was up, and that Four Seasons had appointed its two members to the joint committee for PDC compliance. Craig Nevil remains the primary organizer through the campaign. Musso reported that the Cle Elum council had approved a three-year operating cost subsidy at the previous evening's meeting.

Evergreen Park Update: No developments since the BOA meeting; still waiting out the appeal period.

JWT/CMT Connection: report at next meeting, when Kurtz can be present.

Website: Peterson reported that the District's is up, and ready for more content. Carlin said he had had problems with printing out from the site, which Peterson will look into.

Cle Elum Transportation Plan: next report at September meeting.
